Spectators:

No spectators are allowed during the ICC. Filming and/or photographs can be taken, only if the ICC Committee approve.

ICC Program:

The ICC consist of the following items:

- Pattern preparation and competition execution
- Pad and shield training methods
- Sparring techniques and tactics
- · Power breaking methods and practice
- Jumping technique methods and practice
- Stretching methods
- Coaching
- Physical preparation exercises

Participants must bring their own safety equipment (hand, foot, head guard and groin guard) skipping rope and small hand pad.

Certificate: The ICC certificate of participation will be issued to those who completed the full course.

Due to the popularity of the course, spaces will be allocated on a strict, first come first served basis. Early application is advised.
